- **Order Timeline:** Orders will be accepted from August 28 – September 29, 2017 until 4:30 pm.
- **Ordering Methods:** Residents may submit tree orders by delivering orders to the Avon Town Hall or mailing order forms. Avon Town Hall is open Monday-Friday from 8:00 am – 4:30 pm. If mailing order form, please mail to:

If mailing order, it is highly recommended orders are mailed a minimum of 5 days prior to September 29, 2017. Any orders received after September 29, 2017 at 4:30 pm will be rejected. Payment will need to be mailed in with order form or submitted at the time of delivery. Checks should be made payable to “Town of Avon.”

All trees excluding Colorado Blue Spruce, Emerald Arborvitae, and Saucer Magnolia will be 1.5" caliper and at least 4' tall. River Birch will be in 6' clump form.

- **Street Trees / Hole Digging**

If you are a resident who lives in incorporated town limits, the Town offers a hole digging service. If you are ordering a tree from the approved street tree section, the Town will dig a hole at a designated location between the sidewalk and curb on your residential property. The Town offers this service to encourage residents to plant trees in the parkway.

Available tree species that may be used as street trees are October Glory Maple, Sugar Maple, and Eastern Redbud.

- **Delivery Schedule / Miscellaneous Information**

In-Town Deliveries – Trees are tentatively scheduled for delivery October 9 – October 11, weather permitting. The Town does not provide specific delivery times or call before delivery. Trees are typically delivered between the hours of 8:00 am – 6:00 pm. All delivered trees will be placed between the curb and sidewalk at the time of delivery. If a resident lives in a subdivision that does not have sidewalks, ordered trees will be placed behind the curb.

Out-of-Town Pick-Up – Out-of-town residents will need to pick up tree orders on Saturday, October 14, from 8:00 am – 11:00 am at the Avon Town Hall. This is the only time trees will be available to pick up. Town staff will position the tree next to residents' vehicles so they may be loaded by the driver of the vehicle. Staff does not load tree into vehicle due to liability.

Orders Including Hole Digging – Orders requesting hole digging services will receive their trees and have holes dug October 12, weather permitting. The Town requests residents mark their desired planting locations no later than October 6 so utility locates can be called in by the Town's contractor.

Warranties – There are no warranties on trees.

Tree Descriptions / Photos – Please visit the Arbor Day website to review tree information and see photos of available trees. Residents may visit the site at www.arborday.org.

Address Verification – Residents participating in this program should verify if they live in incorporated town limits. Residents that have an Avon mailing address do not necessarily live in incorporated town limits. This will affect if the Town will provide delivery or hole digging services (if requested).
