- INDOT Representatives came and updated us on a new signal coming in on Rockville Rd. for Costco at their gas station intersection to make it safe and have better flow for vehicles.
- Greg Guerrettaz came and updated the council on the new allowed uses of the ARP Funds
- Council gave their opinions of what each of them would like to see done with these funds.
 - G. Zusan, R. Pope & D. Lowden would like to use some of the funds for purchasing utilities
 - S. Eisenbarth would like to see roads and infrastructure built
 - D. Lowden would like to see the Park land developed
- Council discussed joint Park management with the Township, the consensus was not to go that direction and hire a new Parks Director for the Town. Ryan Cannon has received many applications for the position that he will start going over then and requesting interviews.
