

## **Jim Crowe**

Introduction to Jim Crowe: Jim and Gail Crowe moved to Avon in 1969. Over the years, Jim has been an active member of the library board of trustees, the Board of Zoning Appeals and Planning Commission and the school board. Jim was interviewed by Sandy Curry, a resident of Avon.

### **The Conservancy Board**

Sandy: You are the first person that I've heard of that knows about the Conservancy Board.

Jim: I was one of the original board members and served on it for twelve years...If it hadn't been for the waste disposal system, the community wouldn't have grown...When I came out here, there was no sewer system. The only way the waste was disposed of was by [individual] septic systems...The County Health Department came out with a moratorium that there would be no more houses built in this community because of the saturation of the soil...developers can't get the proper zoning and everything unless you've got [sewers, etc.]...It was a worthy project that I'm proud of. I've seen Avon have tremendous growth.
