Town Hall Park opens new Picnic Shelter

AVON, Ind. – Avon is ready to open the new shelter in Town Hall Park. The shelter is really two shelters joined in the center by a restroom facility and drinking fountain. The shelters have names. The one closest to the lake is Blue Heron, while the other is called Red Fox. Together, they can accommodate up to 100 people. They are equipped with electricity, lights, and charcoal grills. There is also a restroom at the shelter.

Rental rates can apply for either one or both shelters and either full or half days. These are the rates approved by the town council for 2008.

* Non-profit groups will be charged the individual rate for shelters.

Half day rentals are 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. or 4-9 p.m. from April through September and 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. or 3-7 p.m. October through March.

A single shelter can accommodate 50 people.
