Avon expands Town Hall Park by 12.59 acres

AVON, Ind. – Avon Town Hall Park has increased to 83 acres with the purchase of 12.59 acres that expands the park westward. The property is just north of Avon Parkside Nazarene Church and extends the park to County Road 625 East.

The land was purchased below the appraised value for \$10,000 an acre from the Firkins Family. No property taxes were used to purchase the property. Funding is from the Town's food and beverage tax. It consists of mostly open farmland and forest growth. Wildlife including deer and fox frequent the property.

The Town will be developing a master plan for the land. Currently, there are mowed paths throughout the property ideal for a casual walk or mountain bike ride. A row of blackberry plants line a portion of the path. Access to the new parkland is through the tree opening west of the Town Hall Park Barn.

“This is part of the Town's efforts to expand open space and parks for Avon residents,” said Beverley Austin, Town Council Member liaison for parks and recreation.
