

Ordinance 2009-23
Linear Park Trail System

Whereas, the Town of Avon is developing a Linear Park Trail System throughout Town,

Whereas, the Linear Park Trail System consists of trails and sidewalks,

Whereas, the Linear Park Trail System allows residents to actively recreate through walking and biking,

Whereas, the Food and Beverage Tax receipts fund has certain allowable uses and the Linear Park Trail System meets the allowable uses since it is a park facility,


Now, therefore, be it ordained, that Section 2-289 (D) (4) (b) of the Town Code is amended as follows to identify the linear park trail system as an allowable use of Food and Beverage Tax Receipts:

Section 2-289 (D) (4) (b):


Park facilities including the linear park trail system and recreational facilities. A linear park trail system is defined as trails and sidewalks throughout Town that enable residents to recreate by walking and biking throughout the community.






