### **Avon to Host Informational Meeting on County Road 100 South Improvement Project**

(October 4, 2018) The Town of Avon invites residents to attend an informational meeting on County Road 100 South Improvement Project hosted by the Town of Avon on October 10, 2018 from 6:00-7:30 pm at the Light and Life Free Methodist Church.

In 2016, the Town Council and Avon Redevelopment Commission made the decision that they wanted to improve County Road 100 South between Dan Jones Road and the Ronald Reagan Parkway to enhance economic development opportunities and improve traffic flow on County Road 100 South. Avon staff and engineers from American Structurepoint met with neighborhoods in the impacted area of the County Road 100 South Improvement Project. Based on this public input and results of the traffic analysis, the Town intended to construct the improvements in two phases: Phase 1 was going to consist of reconstruction of the existing road, construction of three roundabouts and an improved single-lane in each direction with a boulevard. Phase Two was going to include construction of an additional lane in each direction making County Road 100 South a 4-lane road.

Since then, the Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) has announced an added travel lane project on US Highway 36 from Shiloh Park Drive to east of Raceway Road to begin in 2021. In order to alleviate congestion during the US 36 construction, the Avon Town Council agreed to expedite the entire project and construct both phases of the County Road 100 South Improvements at the same time. This decision was made in cooperation with the Town of Plainfield and Hendricks County who will partner with the Town of Avon on the project.

The County Road 100 South Improvement Project will also include intersection improvements at Ronald Reagan Parkway as well as a dual lane roundabout at County Road 900 East and two additional two-lane roundabouts: one east of County Road 900 East and one west of County Road 900 East. The Roundabouts will provide access for future Light Industrial Development and act as traffic calming for existing residential development in the area. Construction is expected to begin in the second half of 2019 and be completed by the end of 2020.
