**SUBJECT: County Road 200 North Reconstruction Project Update**

Construction activity on the County Road 200 North project is about to begin!

Within the next couple weeks, you will see crews and equipment arriving to begin reconstruction of **County Road 200 North between Dan Jones Road and Ronald Reagan Parkway**. The **general construction work** is scheduled to begin on or around the week of May 20<sup>th</sup>. This project consists of the installation of new storm water control and the reconstruction of the pavement section. The project is expected to last throughout the 2019 season, with some remaining work to be completed in 2020.

The project will be constructed in **two phases**, each with a different road closure and separate maintenance of traffic. Phase I will be the area between County Road 900 E and Ronald Reagan Parkway. This phase is expected to begin late May and be completed around mid-August. Phase II will be the area between Dan Jones Road and County Road 900 E. This closure is expected to begin following the completion of Phase I.

Prior to the road closure for Phase II, the contractor will perform an intermediate closing of County Road 200 North, just east of Dan Jones Road, to replace the culvert crossing. This date is yet to be determined.
