ORDERING METHODS

Please read all ordering information and begin your order by completing the order form on page three. After completing the order form, submit your order in one of two ways:

Check in with the desk attendant to place your order. If you choose to submit your order in-person, you have the option to pay by credit card. A \$3.00 processing fee will be added to your order.

HOLE DIGGING FOR PARKWAY/STREET TREES

If you are a resident who lives within incorporated Avon limits, the Town offers a hole digging service if you order an approved parkway/street tree. The Town will dig a hole at a designated location between the sidewalk and curb on your residential property. We offer this service to encourage Avon residents to plant trees in the parkway.

Available species for the 2019 Spring Tree Sale that may be used as parkway/street trees are: October Glory Red Maple, Burgundy Hearts Redbud, Skyline Locust.

All trees are grown and delivered in containers or bags. Height and caliper varies.

Note: if you have a suggestion for a species you would like to see included in future tree sales, please let us know and we will see if the species is available.

DELIVERY SCHEDULE / MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION

In-Town Deliveries: Trees are tentatively scheduled for delivery on October 16th, 17th, and 18th weather permitting. Delivery date is subject to change. We do not provide specific delivery times or call before delivery. Trees are delivered between the hours of 8:00am – 6:00pm, and placed between the curb and sidewalk at the delivery address. Trees are placed behind the curb for locations without a sidewalk.

Out-of-Town Pick-Up: Out-of-town residents will need to pick up tree orders on October 17th, between 10:00am – 1:00pm at Avon Town Hall. This is the only time trees will be available to pick up. For liability reasons, we are unable to load trees into your vehicle. The Town of Avon is not responsible for any trees left on the lot after the 1:00pm pick up deadline.

Orders Including Hole Digging: If you have requested hole digging services, please call to have utilities located. Visit <http://indiana811.org> for more information. Please mark your desired planting locations with a tagged stake and at least 2 feet from utilities.

Tree Maintenance: Once trees are picked up or delivered to residents, it is no longer the responsibility of the Town of Avon to care for your tree. At this point, you are responsible for all tree care and maintenance.

Address Verification: Residents participating in this program should verify that they live in incorporated town limits. Residents with an Avon mailing address do not necessarily live in incorporated town limits. Avon only provides delivery and hole digging (as requested) for those living in incorporated town limits. To verify whether you are within town limits, please visit <http://www.avongov.org> and click on “Community Maps.” Click search and then search for your address. The address is within incorporated town limits if the Tax District is “Town of Avon.”

Yard Hole Digging: The Town of Avon provides hole digging service for trees planted exclusively in the parkway or easement. If you would like a hole dug in your yard, please contact a landscaping businesses to inquire about hole digging services. A non-exhaustive alphabetical list is provided here:

2019 FALL TREE LIST (PAGE 1 OF 2)

SHADE TREES



October Glory Maple

Fast growing tree with dark green leaves in the spring, summer, and red in the fall. Grows to 40-50' tall with a 35' spread.



Skyline Honey Locust

These trees drops their leaves earlier in the fall which keeps them from being damaged by early hard freezes and heavy snow. 30-50' Tall with a 30-40 spread.



Multi-Stem River Birch

Medium to fast growing. Cinnamon colored, exfoliating bark. Foliage is a medium green in spring and light yellow in fall. 40'-70' tall with a 40'-60' spread.

FLOWERING TREES



Tulip Tree

Fast growing tree with bright green leaves that resemble tulip flowers. Leaves will turn golden yellow in the fall. Grows 70' to 90' tall with a 40' spread.



Burgundy Hearts Red-bud

A spectacular and hardy spring bloomer, with very showy fuchsia flowers held tightly on bare branches in early spring. Grows to 25' tall and 30' wide.



Milky Way Kousa Dogwood

White flowers in May and June give a milky way effect; purple and scarlet fall leaves add intense color. Grows to 15' - 25' high with a 25' spread.



Multi-Stem Autumn Brilliance Serviceberry

Small tree will fit into any sized landscape. Grown either in a single stem tree or a multi stemmed. Suitable for accent planting or privacy screening. Grows to 15' - 25' tall with a 20' spread.

EVERGREEN TREES



Fairview Arborvitae

Slow growth evergreen with emerald green foliage. Emerald arbovitae are typically used for screens or landscaping hedge. This tree will typically grow in a narrow, pyramid formation. Grows 10'-15'
