Final Reading: Ordinance 2019-16: Amending Permit Requirements

Approved. As required by a new state law, the ordinance defines the type of criminal activity that would result in the revocation of a business permit.

Final Reading: Ordinance 2019-17: Creating Redevelopment Authority

Approved. Creates a Redevelopment Authority to finance the construction of the 100 South road widening.

Final Reading: Ordinance 2019-18: Amending PTO policy

Approved. PTO policy was amended to allow a maximum carry over of 240 hours instead of 80 hours starting at the end of 2020 in to 2021.

Final Reading: Ordinance 2019-19: Amending Holiday Leave

Approved. Civilian employees are required to use the holiday on the day of the holiday and police officers may use the holiday at any time. Both are required to use carried over holidays in the first quarter of the new year.

Introduction: Ordinance 2019-20: Amending FMLA Policy

Approved. FMLA policy was amended to require the use of PTO and sick time prior to earning 4 weeks of paid FMLA leave.

Final Reading: Ordinance 2019-21: Additional Appropriation

Approved. Appropriates grant funds and other additional revenue in to the 2019 budget.

Introduced. Establishes salaries and benefits as approved in the 2020 budget. Includes pay grade changes and additional increases above 3% as proposed in the Parks and Public Works budgets.
