Check in with the desk attendant to place your order. If you choose to submit your order in-person, you have the option to pay by credit card with the addition of a \$3.00 processing fee.

DELIVERY SCHEDULE / MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION

In-Town Deliveries: Trees are tentatively scheduled for delivery on Saturday, September 5th. Delivery date is subject to change. We do not provide specific delivery times or call before delivery. Trees are placed between the curb and sidewalk at the delivery address. Trees are placed behind the curb for locations without a sidewalk.

Out-of-Town Pick-Up Deadline: Out-of-town residents must pick up tree orders on Saturday September 5, 2020 between 10:00am – 12:00pm at Avon Town Hall (6570 E US Highway 36). This is the only time trees will be available to pick up. For liability reasons, we are unable to load trees into your vehicle. The Town of Avon is not responsible for orders left on the lot after the 12:00 pm pick-up deadline. Orders continuing to remain on the lot 24 hours after the pick-up deadline the town will assume trees property of the town.

Tree Maintenance: Once trees are picked up or delivered to residents, it is no longer the responsibility of the Town of Avon to care for your tree. At this point, you are responsible for all tree care and maintenance.

In-Town Address Verification: Residents participating in this program should verify that they live in incorporated town limits. Residents with an Avon mailing address do not necessarily live in incorporated town limits. Avon only provides delivery for those residing in incorporated town limits. To verify whether you reside within town limits, please visit <http://www.avongov.org> and click on “Community Maps.” Click search and then search for your address. The address is within incorporated town limits if the Tax District is “Town of Avon.”

No Leaves on Trees: It may be too late in the season for your tree to retain all its leaves. Your tree may be delivered or picked up with few or no leaves.

Autumn Brilliance Serviceberry	15 gallon.....	\$145.00
--------------------------------------	----------------	----------

Amelanchier Autumn Brilliance: Mature height: 20', width: 15'. Heavy stems are covered with clusters of white blossoms in spring and produce an upright, moderately spreading tree or large shrub. Fall foliage is a brilliant red and remains on the tree longer than other cultivars. Reaches mature size early. June fruits are sweet and purplish-black. Resists ice breakage. Light grey bark.



River Birch (Multi-Stem)	20 gallon.....	\$95.00

Betula nigra (Multi-Stem): Mature height: 40', width: 35'. A graceful tree with a broadly pyramidal to rounded head. Younger stems have pink to orange colored bark which darkens as the tree ages. The leaves are diamond shaped, glossy green above, glaucous below. Likes moist sandy soil. Does well in areas that are wet for part of the year. Also will tolerate dry soils. Sun or partial shade. Resistant to bronze birch borer.



Swamp White Oak	20 gallon.....	\$150.00

Quercus Bicolor (Swamp White): Mature height: 45', width: 45'. Beautiful native tree with a rounded, open crown of green foliage with wavy margins. Fall color is yellow-brown to red. Found in low-lying and swampy areas, but can tolerate drought conditions. Requires acid soil.



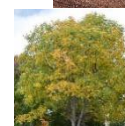
October Glory Red Maple.....	20 gallon.....	\$150.00
------------------------------	----------------	----------

Acer Rubrum "October Glory": Mature height: 40', width: 35'. A popular cultivar with good form, tends to hold its leaves late. Shiny green summer foliage changes to brilliant crimson to reddish-purple in fall. Pale grey bark.



Espresso Kentucky Coffee Tree.....	20 gallon.....	\$200.00
------------------------------------	----------------	----------

Gymnocladus Dioicus "Espresso": Mature height: 50', width: 35. The huge doubly compound leaves give this tree a tropical feel, and the arching branches present an elm-like form. This is a seedless selection. Good tolerance of heat, drought & cold. Bluish-green leaves turn yellow in fall.



Red Oak.....	20 gallon.....	\$175.00

Quercus Rubrum (Red): Mature height: 60', width: 40'. Hardy, rapid-growing, broad-headed tree. Rich green color of summer becomes deep red in fall. Withstands city pollution better than many other of the species. An excellent shade tree. Native to Indiana.



Coralburst Crabapple Standard.....	15 gallon.....	\$130.00

Cercis Canadensis: Mature height: 10-15', width: 10-15'. Compact, dense, rounded crabapple grafted on a standard. Very slow growing. Foliage is dark green. Coral buds open to double, rose-colored flowers. Excellent cedar-apple rust, mildew and fireblight resistance.



Skyline Honeylocust.....	15 gallon.....	\$150.00

Gleditsia Triacanthos Skyline: Mature height: 45', width: 45'. The most widely used of the Honeylocust cultivars. It is a strong grower developing a shapely crown. Foliage is dark green and larger than other cultivars. Thornless and seedless. Valuable for lightly shaded areas.



Green Giant Arborvitae	15 gallon.....	\$120.00
------------------------------	----------------	----------

Thuja Plicata "Green Giant": Mature height: 30-50', width: 10-15'. Uniform and fast growing, 1-2 feet per year, with dense, fragrant, deer resistant rich green foliage in flattened sprays, borne on horizontal, slightly ascending branches. Excellent as a hedge or specimen plant. No known pest or disease problems. Small, oblong cones emerge green and age to brown and persist into winter. Adaptable to most every soil type, needs little to no pruning to maintain its shape.



Emerald Green Arborvitae.....	7 gallon.....	\$38.00

Thuja Occidentalis "Smaragd" (Emerald Green): Mature height: 12-14', width: 3-4'. Narrow, compact pyramidal evergreen with bright emerald green foliage which holds its color during the winter months.

Alice Oakleaf Hydrangea..... 03 gallon..... \$24.00

Hydrangea Quercifolia "Alice": Mature height: 5-10', width: 5-10'. Vigorous form of Oakleaf Hydrangea. Dark green foliage becomes burgundy in fall. Large 12" creamy white panicles late May through early June.



Annabelle Hydrangea..... 03 gallon..... \$22.00

Hydrangea Arborescens "Annabelle": Mature height: 3-5', width: 4-6'. Low growing shrub with dark green foliage in summer. Extremely large white flowers appear on new wood in mid to late June and continue into September. Thrives in shade. Tolerates rabbits, dry or wet soils, and clay soil.



Black Lace Elderberry 03 gallon..... \$25.00

Sambucus Nigra Black Lace: Mature height: 6', width: 8'. Easy growing, durable shrub, lacy, finely-cut deep purple foliage accented by creamy pink flowers that turn into red berries for the fall.
